## Declaration

## **Compliance Status:**

Partially compliant

This website is partially compliant with the requirements set out in Appendix A of the UNI CEI EN 301549 standard due to the non-compliance issues listed below.

#### Non-accessible Content

The following content is not accessible for the reasons of non-compliance with Law No. 4 of January 9, 2004:

- C.9.1.1.1 Not all non-text content presented to the user has a text alternative that serves the same purpose;
- C.9.1.3.1 In some cases, information, structure, or relationships conveyed by page presentation cannot be programmatically determined (or are not available via text);
- C.9.1.4.3 The visual representation of text and images containing text does not always meet the minimum contrast ratio required, except for exceptions provided by law (e.g., logos);
- C.9.1.4.11 For some essential components, even in different states, the color contrast with adjacent elements does not exceed the 3:1 ratio:

- C.9.2.4.4 The purpose of some links cannot be determined from the link text or from the link text together with adjacent content;
- C.9.2.4.7 Some interactive elements do not visibly show the focus indicator;
- C.9.3.3.1 In some cases, when an input error is automatically detected, the erroneous element is not identified and/or the error is not described via text;
- C.9.4.1.2 In some cases, user interface components (including form elements, links, and script-generated components) do not have correct or set names, roles, states, properties, and values, or users and assistive technologies are not notified when these change.
