This website is partially compliant with the requirements set out in Appendix A of the UNI CEI EN 301549 standard due to the non-compliance issues listed below.

Non-accessible Content

The following content is not accessible for the reasons of non-compliance with Law No. 4 of January 9, 2004:

- C.9.1.1.1 - Not all non-text content presented to the user has a text alternative that serves the same purpose;
- C.9.1.3.1 - In some cases, information, structure, or relationships conveyed by page presentation cannot be programmatically determined (or are not available via text);
- C.9.1.4.3 - The visual representation of text and images containing text does not always meet the minimum contrast ratio required, except for exceptions provided by law (e.g., logos);

- C.9.4.1.2 - In some cases, user interface components (including form elements, links, and script-generated components) do not have correct or set names, roles, states, properties, and values, or users and assistive technologies are not notified when these change.
